She may want to worship God but be tormented by feelings of shame and insecurity. He may want to ask for help but fear rejection or judgment. By coming through your doors, they've demonstrated a desire to be part of a community, but they may need someone to show them how.

Our new Aftercare Program was created to assist graduates from our programs as they transition back into the community.
