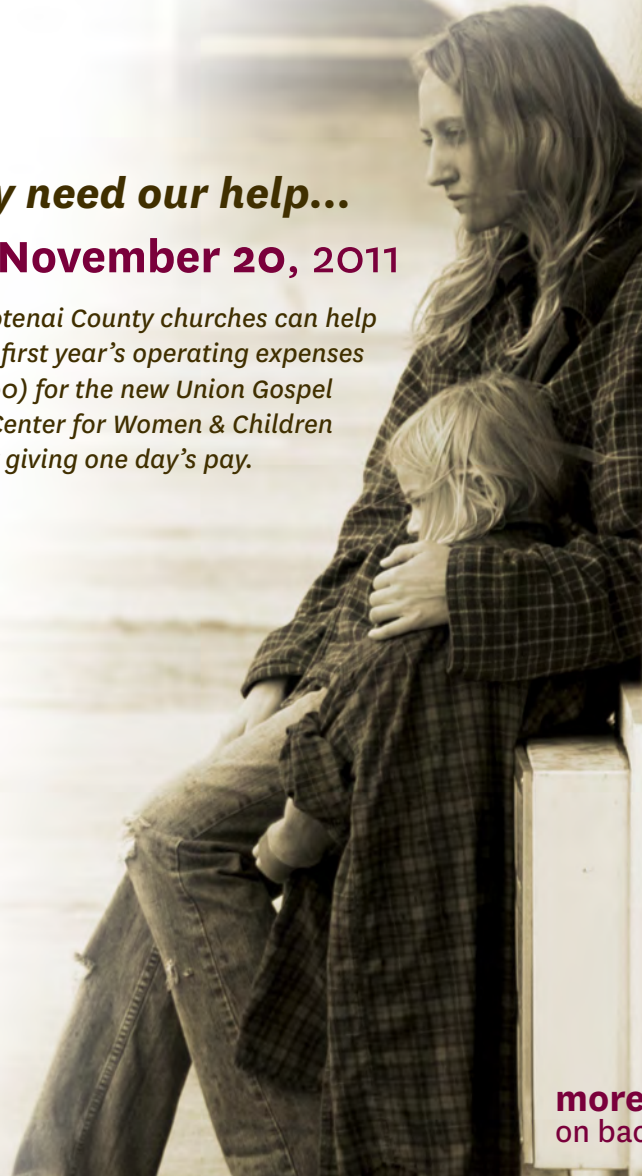

UNION GOSPEL MISSION

UGM impacts lives through three areas of ministry:

Rescue, Recovery and Restoration.

Since 1951, the Union Gospel Mission has been meeting the physical needs of people in crisis. Food, shelter and clothing, however, are just the beginning. The end goal for our clients is freedom in Jesus Christ – a realization that they are loved by God and significant as His children. Such change impacts every aspect of their lives: physical, emotional, intellectual, social and spiritual.

Kootenai County does not currently have a long-term residential recovery center for women and children.

559 homeless individuals

were counted on a single night in January 2011.

7 out of 10 were unsheltered

41% were female

25% were under 18

Centrally located on over 3 acres in Coeur d'Alene, the facility at **196 W Haycraft** will accommodate both rescue and recovery guests with an overall capacity of 80 to 100. **The Center is projected to open August 2012.**

Features: 6 rooms devoted to rescue, 28 rooms devoted to recovery, kitchen & dining room, chapel, medical clinic, classrooms & computer lab, child care center
