Donation Guidelines

Due to the growing cost of disposing of unsaleable items, Union Gospel Mission is forced to make adjustments in the items we can receive as donations. We greatly appreciate you giving good gifts that we can provide to our community at a low cost. The following guidelines describe items we can and cannot receive. Items listed as unacceptable will have to be turned away because we can't sell or clean them, can't test them properly, or have insufficient space to store them.

Thank you for your understanding and for giving good gifts!

APPLIANCES: Clean, in good working order, all parts included. No gas appliances.

BOOKS/MEDIA: No National Geographic magazines, pornography, encyclopedias, or home-recorded videos, tapes, or CDs

COMPUTERS & ACCESSORIES: Only Pentium2 or newer processor, USB port in back, 17" or larger screens. Operating systems must be Windows 98 or newer. No printers, fax machines, scanners, or copiers.

CARPETING: No stains or rips on area rugs and smaller carpets. Larger carpets must be pre-approved.

CAR SEATS & BABY CRIBS: Legal regulations prohibit us from selling car seats 4 yrs old or older. Accepted car seats must be clean and complete with strap attachments. Cribs must have all hardware, and crib slats must be no more than 3.5" apart.

ELECTRONICS: Must be complete, in good working order, with required cords and adapters included. Lamps and other light fixtures must come with attached cords and clean lampshades. No ceiling fans. TVs must include remotes and be cable-ready; no dial-operated units or consoles. No movie cameras or slide projectors.

MICROWAVES: Clean and in good working order. No larger than 24"Wx15"Hx18"D.

VACUUMS: Clean and in good working order.

SPORTS EQUIPMENT: No snow skis or snow boots or large exercise equipment unless pre-approved.

HOUSEHOLD & HARDWARE: Window blinds must include hardware. Newer Tupperware with correct lids, not yellowed or cracked. Dishes and glassware must be unchipped, and unscratched. No Seal-A-Meal units. Newer vaporizers and humidifiers only. Sinks, toilets, and other large fixtures can go to Habitat for Humanity.

FURNITURE: No waterbeds, futon beds, or metal desks. Furniture must be assembled.

MATTRESSES: No stains or rips; no box springs without mattresses.

LINENS: Sheets, blankets, bedspreads, & pillows must be clean, without rips or stains.

MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS: No organs. Only pre-approved pianos. Other instruments complete, in good working order.

MISCELLANEOUS: No hard suitcases, cubicles, or typewriters. Newer or gently used toys, puzzles, and stuffed animals. Auto tires must have 75% tread. No Christmas items temporarily; please ask for update.
